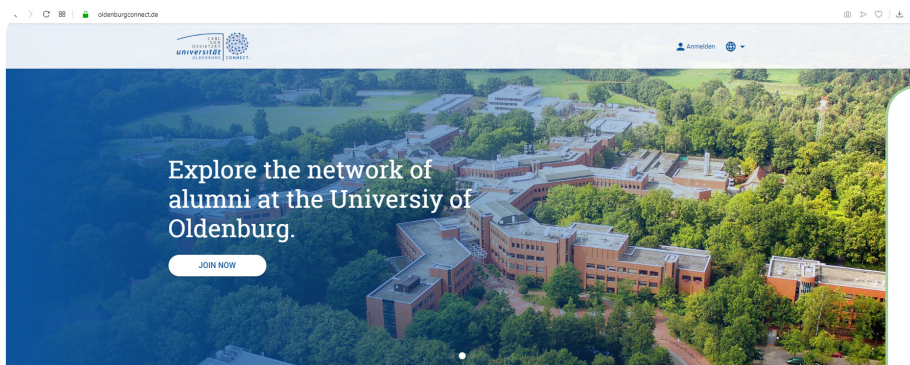


How to register at OldenburgConnect

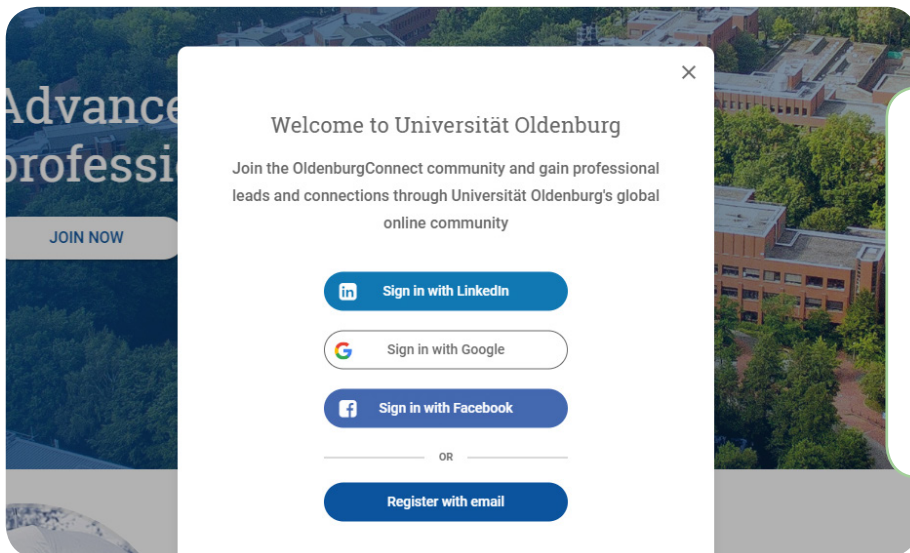
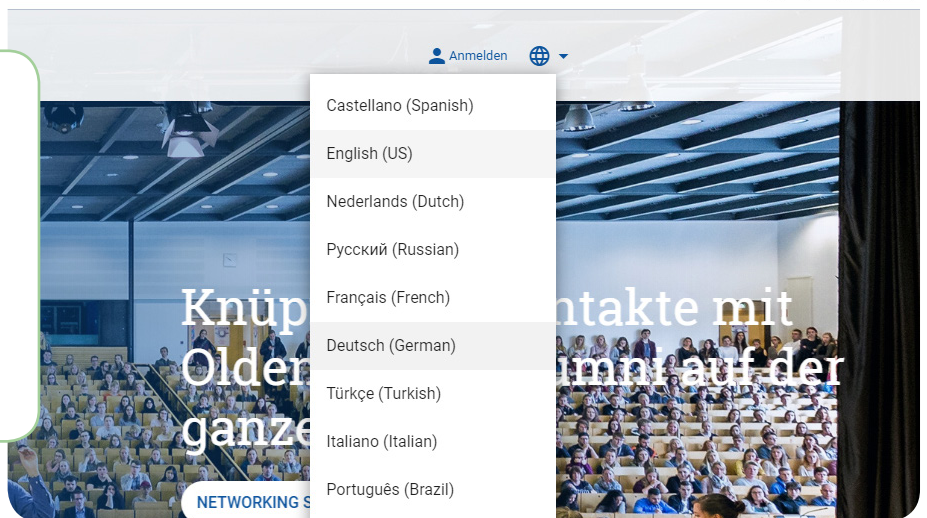
Unsere Verbindungen halten fürs Leben

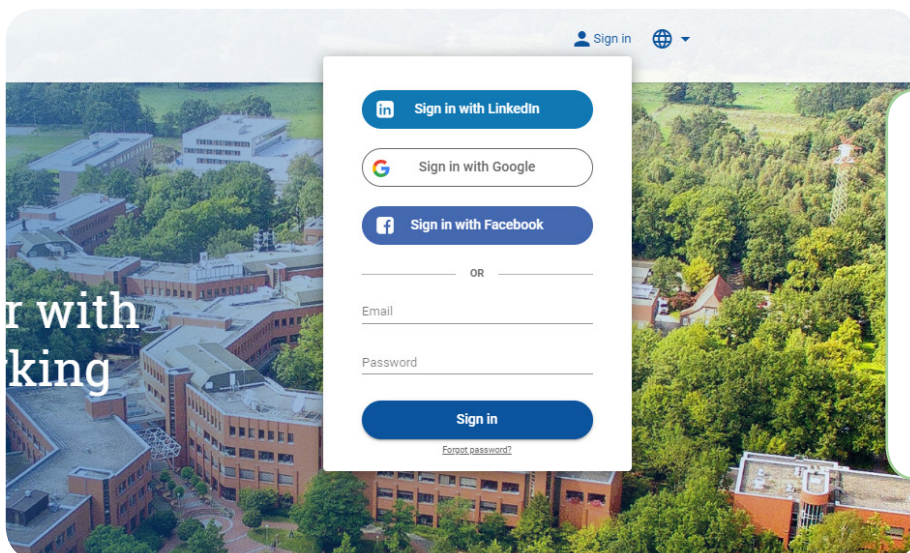
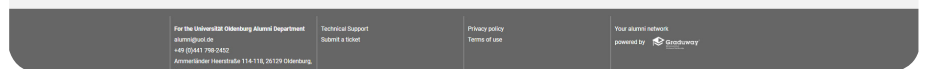
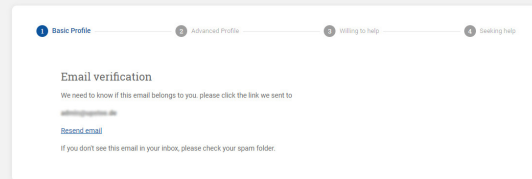
In the first step of registration, please select *WorldCUR* as your affiliation to the university. This will save you from entering all kinds of information requested from regular alumni.

After the first phase, **verify your e-mail address**. Then follow the link in the e-mail to **complete your primary profile information**.

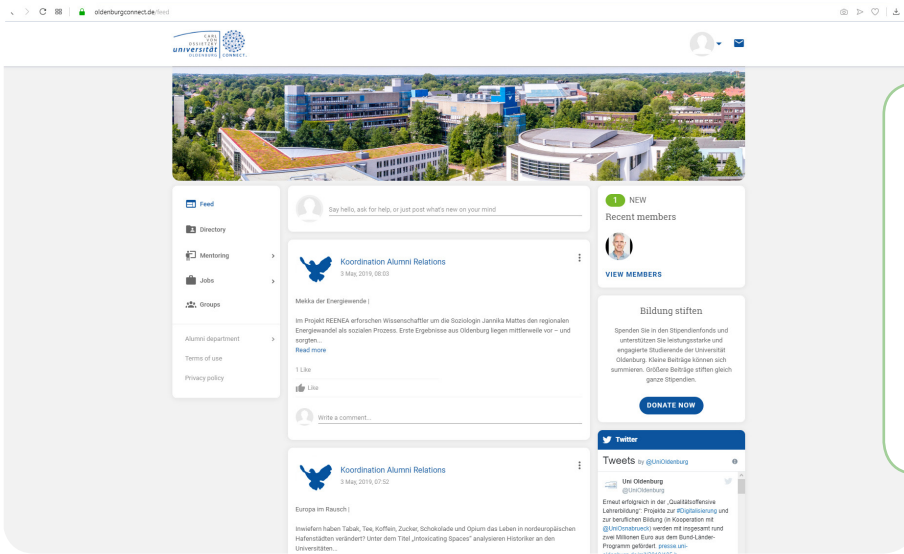
You need access to the e-mail address you enter during registration as you need to verify your application using a link sent to that address.



After your account has been approved (which may take some days), **log in on the landing page**.

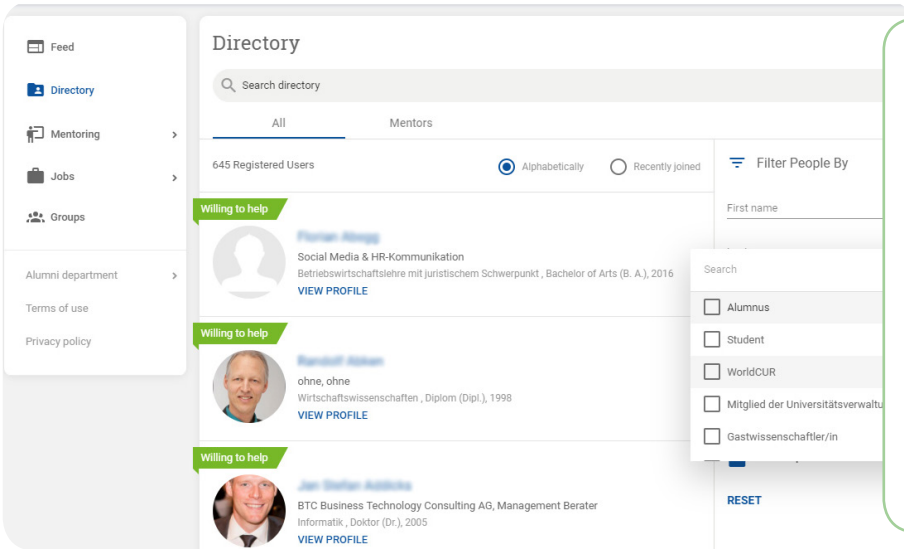
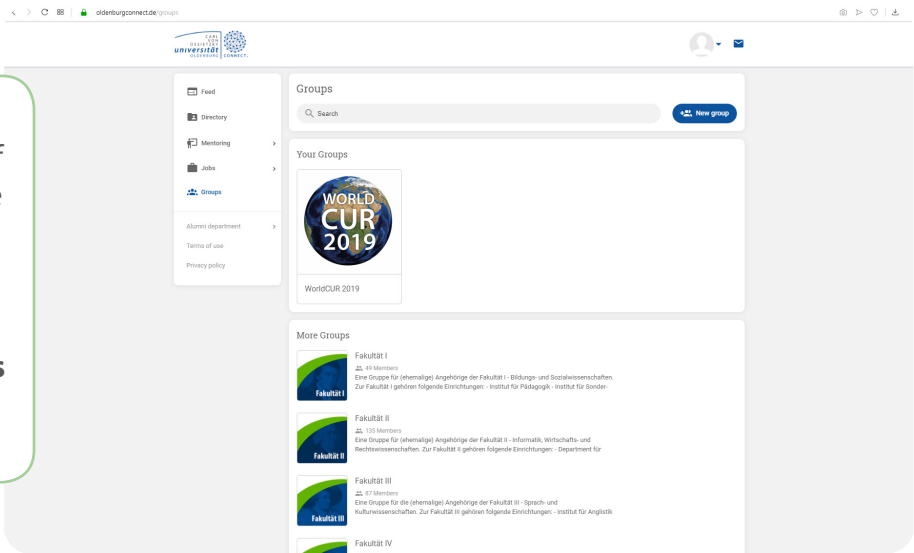
As a next step, you may want to update your profile, perhaps to add a picture or some social media information.

How to register at OldenburgConnect



When you enter the platform for the first time, most of the content you see provided by other members will be in German. Do not be discouraged. As you have experienced, the University of Oldenburg welcomes international exchange. **Feel free to use the feed as you please, in English, French, Spanish, even Mandarin.**

Following the menu to the Groups page, you will notice that you are already part of the **WorldCUR 2019 group**. New users are automatically added to the group when selecting *WorldCUR* as their affiliation during the registration process. In that group you can **post to your hearts content, look up other members, and engage.**



In the group as well as on the platform as a whole **there is a Directory**, a list of members. You can use it to find other people according to a variety of criteria. Perhaps you will even find an Oldenburg University alum who happens to live near you, or one who shares your research interests. Explore, and **contact people via feed, in the group, or through personal message.**
